Registration Booth

- The Registration Booth will be located next to Community #1.
- Please register here at least 1 hour prior to your first game.
- This is also the location where scores will be turned in and the bracket results will be kept.

Drop-Off and Parking Locations

There will be a drop off location near each field. This will be an area that parking will not be allowed, but you can pull up and drop off your equipment and then go and find a parking spot. These areas will be designated by signs. The following are drop-off area locations for each age group:

14u & 15u

For Games at Community #1, near the main concession in the parking lot North of the field
For games at Lazenby Field, in the Rogers Elementary School parking lot.

13u

For Games at Community #2, near the corner of Oxford and Gardner to the West of field

12u

For Games at Merchants #2, on Bacon Avenue West of the field

11u

For Games at Community #3, in a few of the parking spots to the South of the field

10u

For Games at Merchants #1, on Bacon Avenue West of the field, and in a few of the parking spots to the South of the field on Cambridge Rd.

9u

For Games at Angell Field, in a few of the parking spots to the South of the field, on the Bacon Ave. to the East of the field, and in the lot to the North of the field next to the school..

Parking

There will be a number of parking spots available located near each of the fields. However, some people will need to park on the streets as well. If you choose to park on the streets, please be respectful to the Berkley residents and park legally (ie. do not block driveways, etc). Also, please pass this information on to your parents.

Concessions

- The main concession stand will be located behind Community #1.
- A concession stand will be located between Community # 2 and Community #3.
- A small concession stand will be available between the Merchants Fields
- A small concession stand may be available at Angell and Lazenby Fields depending on volunteers.
